

#### Iguazú Falls 4D/3N

### Day 1 - Puerto Iguazú

Alter arrival to Puerto Iguazú's airport or bus station, transfer to your hotel.

## Day 2 - Visit to the Iguazu Falls - Argentina side

Breakfast. Full day excursion to "Parque Nacional Iguazú", Argentina side.



Situated in Iguazú National Park, some 20 km. from Puerto Iguazú in the north of the province, these falls are shared by Brazil and Argentina. Iguazú River is born in Paraná state in Brazil, and after crossing 1,200 km. on a plateau where it receives several affluents, it reaches a fault forming a crack in the interleaved layers of sandstone and basalt where the river runs. There are two basic circuits: an upper path and a lower path:

The lower path leads to the base of the falls, where the spray moistens visitors. It is a unique experience, worth daring the adventure. In this circuit you may also take a boat to Isla San Martín. From the upper path you have panoramic views from the footbridge in an unforgettable experience

Leaving from Cataratas station, we go to the footbridge on the upper part of the river. We get to the balcony on the Devil's Throat, the biggest fall with such a big flow of water that you will be overcome by the grandeur of the scenery

### Day 3 - Visit to the Iguazu Falls - Brazil side + Itaipu Dam

Breakfast. Half day excursions to Parque Nacional Foz do Iguaçu + Itaipu Dam

The tour to the Brazilian Waterfalls begins at Foz do Iguaçu National Park Administrative Office by bus. During this trip, information on the natural environment is provided in Portuguese, Spanish, and English. Inside Foz do Iguaçu National Park, you can enjoy a general view of the natural scenery: orchids, palm trees, bromeliads, and century-old trees, as well as wild animals that occasionally cross the path. The bus drives on to the Waterfalls path to get even closer to nature and the most impressive views.



Along a 1.2-kilometer (0.7 mi.) path of stairs of medium-level difficulty, several observation points are available for visitors to watch the different falls, until arriving at the main attraction: the Devil's Throat, an 80-meter (262 ft.) waterfall.

Crossing to Brazil side, apart of getting dazzled at the fantastic picture of Iguazú Falls, you can visit Itaipú Hydroelectric Factory which is considered hte seventh created wonder of Modern World. Built on Paraná River, in the frontier with Brazil and Paraguay, with installed power of 12,600 MW, Itaipú Hydroelectric Factory is responsible of generating 25% of the Electric energy used in Brazil and of 95% of the energy used in Paraguay.
